2. DEFINITION OF THE EVENT

- 2.1. Kalahari Rally Promotors, in Association with “Rallye Breslau International Association” (Hereafter referred to as KR18), under WOMZA is the organizer of the 2018 “Kalahari Rally”.
- 2.2. The event is organized in compliance with the **Technical Regulations**, **Supplementary Regulations** and **Appendices**, which supersede any other regulations, and will be posted on the **KR18** website. All competitors undertake to comply with these regulations and subsequent amendments, by simple fact of their entry. Should an item not be covered by these regulations then the Jury has the final decision.
- 2.3. The organizers have the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstances arise which make such an action necessary.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

- 4.1. The event will Start and Finish in Mahikeng, North West Province, South Africa.
- 4.2. The covered distance will be approx. 2800 km
- 4.3. Most of the Special Stages will be on gravel and dirt road terrain, approx. 1800 km of Special Stages, plus the Liaison Section also mostly on dirt roads.
- 4.4. The event is separated in to 6 Stages
- 4.5. Starting order and interval between the Categories will be noted in starting lists.
- 4.6. The Route will be described in a road book (see article 17 – ROADBOOK AND NAVIGATION from the General Regulations) and the prescribed route will be mandatory. Secret passage controls (WPM) will be established to ensure compliance.
- 4.7. **Special Stages are run on sections of 'dirt roads' open to the public.** The greatest care is recommended in relation to other possible users.

5. MARATHON STAGE

- 5.1 There will be a Marathon Stage that will be announced in the final Rally Guide.
- 5.2 Water will be supplied to all competitors for the Marathon Stage & ALL other Stages.
- 5.3 Competitors must supply their own camping mattress & sleeping bag, that will be transported to the Marathon Bivouac by the KR18 organization.
- 5.3 Crew Bivouac for the Marathon Stage will also be announced in the final Rally Guide.

7. ENTRIES, COMPETITORS ELIGIBILITY

- 7.1. Complies with article 8 of the General Regulations
- 7.2. Competitor **MUST** have a Valid WOMZA Competition License.
- 7.3. WOMZA License can be purchased for R100, at Documentation on Saturday 13 October 2018.
- 7.4. The entry application will be considered as valid after the complete payment of the entry fee.
If the entry is fully subscribed, the organizers may allow entries on a reserve list.
- 7.5. Permission for reserve entries to run may only be granted by the organizers.

8.3. Down Payment (Deposit):

To validate the registration, every crew must pay the Down Payment (deposit) corresponding to the class in which it is entering, maximum 2 weeks after the entry has been sent. The receipt of Down payment on our account is the decisive date for marking the entry period and entry fee. The down payment is a part of the total amount.

The **KR18** reserves the right not to validate registrations if a down payment has not been paid within 2 weeks after submitting the online registration. In this case the online registration will be deleted.

The Race Number **will be published on the website**, after receiving the Down Payment (deposit) in the account of **KR18**.

8.4. The ENTRY Down Payment/Deposit is NOT Refundable.

8.9. Payment Terms: (Refer to the Website for Payment Dates– Entry Fees)

To validate the registration, every crew must pay the Down Payment (deposit) corresponding to the class in which it is entering, maximum 2 weeks after the entry has been sent. The down payment is a part of the total amount. The down payment is not refundable.

Prior to the administrative check, the full amount of the entry fee must be paid. As a reference the participant must enter full name and booking number. The receipt of payment is the decisive date.

IMPORTANT: Participants who pay their entries on the day of registration closing dates must show copy/document of the fees paid at the Administrative Check on site.

IMPORTANT: NO BANK CHEQUES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

IMPORTANT: ALL Bank Charges incurred must be paid by the sender.

IMPORTANT: ALL PAYMENTS ARE South African Rand (ZAR) based

IMPORTANT: THE ORGANISER RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO VALIDATE REGISTRATIONS OF ENTRANTS:

- Who have not paid the down payment (deposit) within 4 weeks after submitting the online registration; In this case the online registration will be deleted.
- Who have not fully paid the total amount of the entry fee by the time of the Administrative check on Saturday 13 October 2018.

8.10. Entries AFTER the Closing Date:

May be accepted with the approval of the Rally Administration.

Please contact Rally Administration. In this case the entry application will be validated at the Administrative Check 13 October 2018 only if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee (valid for that period) paid on site.

8.11. CANCELATION & TRANSFERS

Registrations are by name and they are **STRICTLY NON - REFUNDABLE.**

Competitors may transfer an entry to another name until 30 August 2018 without penalty.

ANY TRANSFERS AFTER the 30 September 2018 will incur an Admin Penalty of R3000.

IMPORTANT: No transfer of any payments of entry fees from KR18 to KR19!

9. INSURANCE – EVENT INSURANCE & COMPETITOR MEDICAL COVER

9.4. This contract assures financial coverage of damages caused to third parties by the Organizer or by the competitors. This insurance come into effect from 13 October 2018 at 00:00 a.m. till 19 October 2018 at 11:59 p.m.

9.5. This insurance coverage applies only to the Special Stages & Liaison Sections of the itinerary, run for best time, achieving the maximum speed. It begins already from entering the Control Zone (yellow sign "notice time control") at the start of a Stage and ends with the end of the Control Zone (beige sign "control zone end") at the finish of the Stage.

9.6. COMPETITOR MEDICAL COVER

S.A. COMPETITORS:

Must have valid Medical Cover for the event from either their own Insurance provider or take out a WOMZA Medical Cover. **Proof will be required at Documentation.**

WOMZA

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INTERNATIONAL COMPETITORS:

Must have valid Medical Cover for the event from either their own Insurance provider and must include Medical & Death Repatriation. **Proof will be required at Documentation.**

13. PROTESTS - APPEALS

13.1. Complies with article 41 the KR18 & General Regulations

13.2. The fee for a protest is R1000 – NON REFUNDABLE

13.3. The fee for a protest is R3000 – NON REFUNDABLE

13.4. Protests cannot be handled after the first competitor on the course has left the next stage following this posting.

13.5. NO Protest for the last race Stage MUST be submitted with 1hr after the publishing the provisional general classification.

13.6. **FINDINGS BY THE JURY/STEWARDS ON APPEALS AT THE EVENT, WILL BE FINAL!**

14. PRIZES – TROPHIES

14.1. Prizes will be awarded to the winners at the official Prize-giving Ceremony.

14.2. Medals will be awarded on the Podium at the Finish of Stage 6

14.3. Awards Dinner & Trophies, as well as Special Awards, will be as per the Categories & Classes, will take place at the **Mafikeng Rugby Club Field Bivouac, 19 October 2018 19h00**

15. PRIZE GIVING DINNER

The **Prize-Giving Dinner** will take place at the Mafikeng Rugby Club Bivouac – Mafikeng. All members of the crew must be present at the prize-giving. Crews who are NOT present at the prize-giving **WILL** forfeit their prizes; however, the final classification will not be modified.

16. CATERING

- The Entry includes catering services, starting with a Cocktail dinner on Saturday evening 13 October 2018 and ending with a breakfast on Saturday morning 19 October 2018 at the Mafikeng Rugby Club.
- The daily menu consists of a Breakfast, Catered Lunch at the End of Special Stage and Dinner.
- Caution: The Catering does **NOT** include drinks, except water, coffee and tea at the breakfast.
- WATER is available for all competitors at the Start & Finish of the Stage Specials & at the Marathon Stage Overnight
