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1. DEFINITION OF THE EVENT

- 1.1. *Kalahari Rally Promotors, in Association with "RBI Sport"* (Hereafter referred to as KR-XX21), under WOMZA, is the organizer of the 2021 "Kalahari Rally".
- 1.2. The event is organized by *Kalahari Rally* in association with *RBI Sporting Regulations 2021, KR Technical Regulations* and these <u>Supplementary Regulations</u> and <u>Appendices</u>, which supersede any other regulations, and will be posted on the *KRXX21* website. All competitors undertake to comply with these regulations and subsequent amendments, by simple fact of their entry. Should an item not be covered by these regulations then the Stewards has the final decision.
- 1.3. The organizers have the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstances arise which make such an action necessary.

3. DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

3.1. The event will Start in Mahikeng, North West Province, South Africa go through the Northern Cape, and finish in Mafikeng. The covered distance will be approx. 3400 km. Special Stages will be on gravel and dirt road terrain, approx. 1900 km of Special Stages, plus the Liaison Section mostly on dirt roads.

The event is separated in to 6 Stages + Super Special Stage,

- 3.2. The Super Special Stage will <u>NOT</u> be counted for the General Classification.
- 3.3. Results of the Super Special Stage will be used for the starting order of Stage 1. Starting order and interval between the Categories will be noted in starting lists. The Route will be described in a road book (see article 17 ROADBOOK AND NAVIGATION from the General Regulations) and the prescribed route will be mandatory. Secret passage controls will be established to ensure compliance.
- 3.4. <u>Special Stages are run on sections of 'dirt roads' open to the public.</u> The greatest care is recommended in relation to other possible users.

Prior to the administrative check, the full amount of the entry fee must be paid. As a reference the participant must enter full name. The receipt of payment is the decisive date.

IMPORTANT: ALL Bank Charges incurred must be paid by the sender.

IMPORTANT: THE ORGANISER RESERVES THE RIGHT NOT TO VALIDATE REGISTRATIONS OF ENTRANTS:

- Who have not paid the Entry Fees within 4 weeks after submitting the online registration; In this case the online registration will be deleted.
- Who have not fully paid the total amount of the entry fee by the Close of Entries, 30 July 2021.

7.10. Entries AFTER the Closing Date:

May be accepted with the approval of the Rally Administration.

Please contact Rally Administration. In this case the LATE ENTRY application will be validated at the Administrative Check 2 September 2021 only, and if accompanied by the total amount of the entry fee (valid for that period) paid on site.

7.11. **CANCELATION & TRANFERS**

Registrations are by name and they are **STRICTLY NON - REFUNDABLE.**

Competitors may transfer an entry to another name until 30 July 2021 without penalty.

ANY TRANSFERS AFTER the 30 July 2021 will incur an Admin Penalty of R3000.

IMPORTANT: NO transfer of any payments of entry fees from KRXX21 to KR22!

8. INSURANCE – EVENT INSURANCE & COMPETITOR MECIAL COVER

- 8.1. KRXX21 Complies with RBI Sporting Regulations & WOMZA
- 8.2. The Organization has subscribed a General Third Party Liability insurance policy with WOMZA for sporting event in accordance with the running legislation.

- 8.3. All Competitors must complete a WOMZA License Application, *Included in Entry Fee*, in person at Admin Checks
- 8.4. This contract assures financial coverage of damages caused to third parties by the Organizer or by the competitors. This insurance come into effect from 1 September 2021 at 00:00 a.m. till 11 September 2021 at 11:59 p.m.
- 8.5. This insurance coverage applies only to the Special Stages & Liaison Sections of the itinerary, run for best time, achieving the maximum speed. It begins already from entering the Control Zone (yellow sign "notice time control") at the start of a Stage and ends with the end of the Control Zone (beige sign "control zone end") at the finish of the Stage.

8.6. **COMPETITOR MEDICAL COVER**

S.A. COMPETITORS:

Must have valid Medical Cover with minimum value of <u>R500,000.00</u> for the event, from either own Insurance provider or take out a WOMZA Medical Cover. **Proof will be required at Documentation.**



INTERNATIONAL COMPETITORS:

Must have valid Medical Cover for the event from either their own Insurance provider with a minimum value of *R1000,000.00* for the event and must include Medical & Death Repatriation.

Proof will be required at Documentation.

14.ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS AND TECHNICAL INSPECTION

The Administrative Check & Technical Inspection will take place at *Mafikeng Rugby Club*. Starts 3 September 2021. Times for each competitor will be posted on the website.

<u>NOTE:</u> ALL DRIVERS/NAVIGATORS/RIDERS & ALL CREW, <u>MUST</u> go through Administrative Checks to sign documents in person!

15. RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- 15.1. Complies with KR-XX21 Supplementary Regulations and RBI Sporting Regulations

 Special Stages are run on sections of 'road' open to the public. The greatest care is recommended in relation to other eventual users
- 15.2. It is forbidden to participate under the influence of drugs, alcohol, strong medicines or similar.

 ZERO TOLLERANCE on alcohol! Random checks will be carried out at the start of the Stages.

 If drivers fail an alcohol test, they will not be allowed to start, and may be excluded!

16. SUPER SPECIAL STAGE

- 16.1. The SUPER SPECIAL will be run as a Stage on 3rd September 2021 starting at 12:00h and will determine the starting position for the following day.
- 16.2. Classification of the SUPER SPECIAL Stage, as well as any penalties for Road Sections of the Super Special Stage relating thereto, <u>WILL NOT</u> count towards the classification of the Kalahari Rally 2021. All penalties will be taken into account for the SUPER SPECIAL Stage classification and will only determine the starting order for Stage 1.

17. MARATHON STAGE

17.1. There will be **NO** Marathon Stage for KR-XX21

18. IRON MAN

- 18.1. Competitors in this Category may not receive any assistance from any service crew at any time during the rally, Special Stages or in the Bivouac.
- 18.2. Competitors may buy or ask for parts from teams, or tools from any crews or competitors, however these parts must be fitted by the "Iron Man" competitor.
- 18.3. ALL work must be done by the rider, however "Iron Man" competitors may assist each other.
- 18.4. Any repair tools may be borrowed from service crews must be done by the rider.
- 18.5. "Iron Man" competitors **MUST** camp and remain in the Bivouac.

NO CAMPER VANS, B&B's OR SIMILAR ALLOWED!

18.6. Iron Man Allowance: 1 x Box (80L), 2 x Fitted Spares wheels, Hiking Tent & Sleeping bag These will be transported by the KR Organization.



19. WAYPOINTS

Complies with Kalahari Rally Regulations and RBI Sporting Regulations.

20. SPEED CONTROL ZONES

See *Penalties* in Appendix below.

21. MAXIMUM PERMITTED LATENESS

Any crew reporting more than 120 minutes late at the Start of a Stage from their due time (the first Time Control of the current Stage), shall NOT be allowed to start that Stage and will be deemed to have retired from the Stage. In calculating such Lateness time, the actual time and not the penalty time (10 seconds per minute) applies.

The crew may be allowed to start after authorization of the Clerk of the Course and receiving a penalty.

22. DNF/CUT&RUN

22.1. Definition: "Cut & Run":

If a driver obtains the status DNF or DNS, he can start the next Stage with a time penalty for the remainder of the Stage of Slowest Time in Category +20min . Only the first application of "Cut & Run" will classify the drivers as a finisher. The second time a "Cut & Run" will not classify the driver as finisher, but he can start the next Stages with a fixed time penalties applied.

22.2. Definition: "Safety Cut Off":

At a Pre-Determined Passage Control (PC), the drivers who arrive late at the PC will be "Cut Off" and stopped by the PC Marshal. This "Safety Cut Off" will allow the drivers to start the next Stage with a time penalty for the remainder of the Stage and <u>WILL</u> be classified as a finisher of KR-XX21. <u>Note:</u> Drivers who drive abnormally slow based on their skills, will be reported to the Stewards.

Drivers are allowed only one "Safety Cut Off" to be classified as finishers. The second time a "Safety Cut Off" is applied, the drivers will NOT be classified as finishers, but they can start the next stages with a Fixed time penalties.

22.3. Application of: 1st & 2nd Cut & Run:

- 22.3.1.1. The 1st "Cut & Run" with Penalty Applied, but will CLASSIFY as a finisher!
- 22.3.1.2. The **2**nd **Cut & Run"** with Penalty Applied, but will **NOT BE CLASSIFIED** as a finisher!

22.4. Did Not Start (DNS)

The competitor obtains the status DNS, if he does not start the first Special Stage of the Stage. In this case, he misses the whole Stage. The fixed penalty for DNS of the Stage are for each Special Stage, the Slowest Times in the Category (including incurred sporting penalties) + 30 minutes each.

If a competitor takes the start of the first Special Stage of the Stage, but misses a following Special Stage/s, he automatically obtains a DNS status for the missed Special Stage /s. In this case the fixed penalty for DNS is the Slowest Time in the Category of the Special Stage /s (including incurred sporting penalties) not Started + 30 minutes.

If a competitor retires from the Special Stage or does not finish within his Maximum time allowed, without having passed at least 1 Passage Control (PC) or 1 Waypoint of the Special Stage itinerary, he automatically obtains the status DNS.

22.5. Did not Finish (DNF)

The competitor obtains the status DNF, if he retires from a Special Stage or does not finish within his Maximum time allowed, but has passed at least 1 Passage Control (PC) or 1 Waypoint. The penalty for DNF is Slowest time in the Category of the Special Stage (including incurred sporting penalties) + 20 minutes.



23.PENALTIES

See Penalty table in Appendix below.

24. PROTESTS - APPEALS

- 24.1. Complies with article 41 the KR18 General Regulations
- 24.2. The fee for a protest is R1000 NON REFUNDABLE
- 24.3. NO APPEALS. Jury decision will be final.
- 24.4. No Protests allowed after the first competitor has started the next stage, after the posting of results.

 All protest are to be filed until 30 min after publication of provisional classification
- 24.5. Protest for the last Stage must be submitted no later than 30 min after the publishing the provisional classification. **STEWARDS DECISIONS ON APPEALS AT THE EVENT, WILL BE FINAL!**

25. PRIZES – TROPHIES

- 25.1. Prizes will be awarded to the winners at the official Prize-giving Ceremony.
- 25.2. Medals will be awarded on the Podium Ceremony at the Finish of Stage 6.
- 25.3. Awards Dinner & Trophies, as well as Special Awards, will be as per the Categories & Classes, will take place at the **Mafikeng Rugby Club Bivouac**, **10 September 2021**, **19h00**.


