

- 6.2. All Buggies / SXS must have a solid roof firmly fixed to the roll cage. It is highly recommended a firmly fixed metal roof of minimum 1.5mm thickness.
- 6.3. Highly recommended at least 1 diagonal cross member on the roll cage.

7. SPECIFIC SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR MOTO & ATV

- 7.1. Full Off Road Gear.
- 7.2. Moto-cross clothes with chest & back protector, shoulders and knee protectors.
- 7.3. Moto-cross boots (no others will be allowed).
- 7.4. Neck Brace is not compulsory, but recommended.
- 7.5. Min of 3 Litres of Water in a Camel Pack (NO WATER IS REQUIRED ON THE BIKE/ATV)
- 7.6. Compulsory Rally lights for Liaisons Sections at night. **STANDARD ENDURO LIGHTS ARE NOT ALLOWED!**

8. RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

All the necessary spare parts and tools typical for the vehicle should be brought to the rally, sufficient lights (for all stages), a torch, shackles, a high-lift jack, a spade, sand ladders etc. according to your category.

All vehicles, also including the service vehicles and any other vehicles, must have a valid registration and insurance and be roadworthy for the participation in the stages.

9. FUEL AUTONOMY (MINIMUM FUEL REQUIREMENTS)

Each competitor is responsible of the calculation of his autonomy. No claims can be made against the Organization, should the vehicle not reach the coverage of the minimum distance of 250km, irrespective of the nature of the terrain. For safety reasons, an additional autonomy of 10% is recommended.

10. TECHNICAL INSPECTION PROCEDURE

Presenting the vehicle at the Technical Checks is considered as an implicit declaration of conformity.

- 10.1 At the Technical Inspection, there will be controlled, and mandatory technical checks carried out, to confirm adherence to specific technical regulations and mandatory equipment as set out above in paragraphs 4,5,6,7,8,9 above.
- 10.2 Vehicles must be presented in Race Condition as it would be as when presented at each prestart at the beginning of each race Stage.
- 10.3 The racing helmets of the competitors must be presented at the Technical Inspection, and if required additional marking.
- 10.4 The mandatory equipment for the particular category, such as first aid kit, towing straps, recovery accessories **MUST** be presented at Technical Inspection. If needed, the Orga will mark the presented equipment.
- 10.5 All off road gear for Moto & ATV **MUST** be presented for Tech Inspection.
- 10.6 A participant will only receive permission to start the event when **ALL** technical checks, as per the Tech Checks Plan, have been passed. This includes the completed and signed disclaimer.

COMPETITOR & SERVICE CREW VEHICLES:

All competitors & Service Crew Vehicles must pass through Technical Inspection & Decals fitted by Officials with all gear required for every category.
